"Nall has built an acclaimed creative career spanning 45 years having been the recipient of exhibitions in fine art museums as well as prominent design commissions," said curator for the exhibition and Assistant Curator for SCAD Exhibitions Stephanie Greene. He has seamlessly positioned himself for both regional and international appeal, with a sprawling body of work that has proven translatable to a variety of media—paintings, costumes, etchings, silverware, mosaics, assemblage wall pieces, monumental sculpture, video documentations, set designs, drawings, water colors, china, postage stamps, etc.....—and a variety of venues—the museum, the gallery, the stage, and private collections. Nall's art is educational in that he paint themes concerning race, religion, politics, ecology and all other subjects that pertain to current events, giving a transparent perspective to each subject.

Nall (born 1948 Fred Nall Hollis in Troy, Alabama, USA) earned his degree in art, political science and psychology from the University of Alabama in Tuscaloosa. He continued his formal education at the Ecole National Superior des Beaux Arts in Paris, for 5 years. He has exhibited his work throughout the U.S. as well as in shows abroad in Switzerland and at the National Natural History Museum in Paris, France. His participation in international porcelain fairs includes the Caroussel du Louvre in Paris; Stuttgart, Germany; the Château de Bagatelle in Neuilly; at Podium boutique in Moscow, Russia; and in New York's Arts and Crafts Museum and "Murano Memories" group show. His Porcelain has been produced by Haviland and Parlon and Royal Limoges, of Limoges, France. Monaco Porcelain Company and the Tunisian Porcelain Company. Nall has created commissioned works, permanent and non, for specific spaces, exhibitions and figureheads including the National Arts Club, New York, NY; Cathedral of Saint-Paul de Vence; Postage stamps and Monumental Mosaics for H.S.H. Prince Albert II of Monaco; The Tuscany Council for Culture; Puccini Festival Foundation; Miami Dade College, Miami, Florida; Pisa International Airport, Italy; St. Francis Basilica in Assisi, Italy. His monumental sculpture the 'Peace Frame' stands permanently at the entrance of Pietrasanta, Italy, at the Michaelangelo Square. Another of his Peace Frames can be found in Monaco overlooking the Harbor, along with two Monumental Mosaics in the Grimaldi Forum. He has been awarded the Mary Ellen LoPresti ARLIS/Southeast Publishing Award for "Best Art Book" for his creation of "Alabama Art" (Black Belt Press) and has been instrumental in helping other 'Alabama Artists promoting their works in the RSA Hotels in Alabama, in New York City at 55 Water Street, and in France and Italy. He was awarded a Doctorate Honoris Causa from Troy University, Troy, Alabama; and Alabama's Distinguished Artist of the Year award from the Alabama State Council on the Arts. He received the Alabama Image Award for improving the Image of Alabama internationally from the University of Alabama. Numerous books have been published on his work, 'Technique and Symbol' by Alain Renner, 'Alchemy' by Hugues de la Touche, and 'Violata Pax', by Vittorio Scarbi.

He was chosen to exhibit in the Gulf Shores Hangout Music Festival, 2014, 2015, 2016 and has been awarded an Artist's Studio by the Principality of Monaco for the summer of 2013.

His two foundations, the N.A.L.L. Art Association in Vence, France, and the Nall Foundation in Fairhope, Alabama award scholarships to student apprentices to work with him in France and Alabama. Nall generously supports various charities in the USA and Europe, and works tirelessly helping young artists with art education and 12 step programs.
