



Family Campout Quick Facts

Admission

- Tickets must be purchased in advance.
- Staff will meet you in the Blue Parking Lot, next to the solar panels beside the Grisham Pavilion.

Tent Location

- All guests are required to assemble their own tents.
- To facilitate appropriate social distancing, you should assemble your tent far away from other groups.

Face Masks

- **Guests may be asked to wear face masks or face coverings anytime it is not possible to maintain at least six feet of distance from others not in your group.** This includes when picking up dinner or breakfast and when using the restrooms.

Food

- Dinner Menu: Hot dog, potato salad, chips, bottled water, juice boxes, and s'mores
- Breakfast Menu: Packaged muffins or breakfast bars, coffee, and juice boxes
- Please send 1-2 family members to retrieve your food at mealtimes.
- Staff will be wearing appropriate PPE to administer food at mealtimes.
- Tables will be wiped down between guests, and all tables will be placed with appropriate social distancing.
- You are welcome and encouraged to bring additional snacks for your group.

Restrooms

- Restrooms will be cleaned and wiped down every hour by Garden staff.
- A sanitation station will also be set up between restroom doors and will include hand sanitizer and paper towels.

Garden Hikes and Story Time

- Multiple hikes will be offered throughout the evening to allow for smaller groups.
- Story time will be led by staff at the end of the night, after all hikes are completed. Please bring your own chairs or blankets to sit on during story time.
